Daily tickets are a cost-effective and easy way to explore Brisbane using our great CityCats and CityFerries as well as the city's bus and train networks. The inclusions of daily tickets are as follows:

Daily

Unlimited travel on all TransLink services until the last scheduled service of the day* on the date of issue and within the zones printed on the ticket.

Off-peak daily

Discounted unlimited travel between 9am and 3.30pm and after 7pm, and all day on weekends and gazetted public holidays, within the zones printed on the ticket.

Tips for your trip

Validating daily tickets

Remember to present your ticket to the CityCat Ticket Seller or CityFerry Master for validation each time you board a vessel.

Concessions

If you are travelling on a concession fare, remember to keep your concession card with you at all times.

Timetables

Copies of timetables are available onboard vessels, at the Riverside Ferry Information Centre at the Riverside CityCat terminal, and also within the signage displays at all CityCat and CityFerry terminals. Children onboard

Children must remain under parental control in all areas, at all times, and particularly outside the cabin.

Food and drink

Please note that no food or drink (excluding bottled water) is to be consumed onboard vessels.
